INTRODUCTION

These are summary of activities carried out by the UNAMID Police Public Information Office during the week under review and activities carried out by the UNAMID Police Component in the quest for achieving its mandate.

MHQ

-On 30 October 2018 German Ambassador visited Tawilla for the opening ceremony of a Rehabilitation Project of Tawilla Rural Hospital. The German NGO "Lachen Helfen" through the actions of two UNAMID IPOs from German funded the rehabilitation project of the hospital which now has the capacity to cater for 600 patients per day compared to the 40 patients per day that existed before the improvement.



– On 28 October 2018 MHQ Training Unit held a closing ceremony for 26 IPOs from Tanzania, Tunisia, Egypt and Nepal at MHQ in El Fasher. The occasion was graced by UNAMID Training Coordinator Mr Peter Sibanda and MHQ Training Unit Team leader Mr Osama Al-Jaman.



– On 30 October 2018 a Medal Parade for Jordan Contingent was held at the Arc Hall in MHQ, El Fasher where 124 Jordanian Police Officers comprising of 120 males and four females were decorated with UN medals. OIC Police Component Mr Yemane Asnesa and other dignitaries graced the most conspicuous occasion.





SECTOR NORTH

– On the 28 October 2018 SN Training Unit held opening ceremony for a 10-day Community Policing TOT for 15 SPF officers and facilitators comprising of 14 males and one female. The course which is running from 28 October 2018 to 8 November 2018 was graced by SN Deputy Sector Commander Ms Vilisi Mati Waqavesi and Abdul Majid Habub from North Darfur SPF HQ. Ms. Waqavesi commended the Government of Sudan, the SPF, the popular police and other stake holders for their directed efforts to bring back peace to Darfur.



– On 29 October 2018 Saraf Umra TS held a meeting with CPVs on community policing and security of the IDP camp and conduct of patrols within the IDP camp. The CPVs were advised that community policing means that themselves representing the community are the custodians of the community security working together with security organs of the country like SPF and RSF to boost community security.





– On 31 October 2018 UNAMID OIC Sector North Commander Ms Vilisi Mati Waqavesi accompanied by team comprising of UNAMID Training Coordinator Mr Peter Sibanda, SPF HQ team leader, SN OIC R&G, and SN SPF Coordinator visited the Project of Rehabilitation SPF Training Centre which is being built by UNAMID as part of capacity building of SPF and later had a meeting with Brig Afifi about the project at SPF HQ in El Fasher.

SECTOR CENTRAL

– On 29 October 2018 Mourni TS held a meeting with CPVs at Sisi IDPs Camp and advised them on the role of CPVs in society and also conducted a joint patrol with them within the IDPs camp.



– On 30 October 2018 Mourni TS interacted with villagers at Mara Returnee Village and advised them on the roles of women in the community as well as importance of sharing of crime information and other related issues with the CPVs, SPF and UNAMID.

– On 31 October 2018 Mourni TS visited Nur Salam village and advised villagers on importance of using dialogue in resolving issues in their communities and the importance of reporting sexual offences to SPF.



SECTOR SOUTH

– On 26 October 2018 Nyala 2 TS Kalma Patrol team held a meeting with SPF officer at BELEIL station and advised them on how to treat and handle SGBV cases professionally. The team later interacted with IDPs at and sensitized them role of women in decision making.



– On 28 October 2018 Nyala 2 TS Kalma Patrol team interacted with internally displaced women at Kalma IDPs camp and advised on the importance of women empowerment and engaging in some work which can earn them money to feed their families such as planting vegetables and creating small scale businesses.



FORMED POLICE UNIT

– On 29 October 2018 INA FPU conducted a workshop on the dangers of mosquito bites and malaria in Garuda Camp which was attended by participants.



– On 31 October 2018 INA FPU conducted training for Government of Sudan prison personnel on State prisons administration, Hostage taking and Survival techniques.



– On 31 October 2018 INA FPU Deputy commander visited Golo and met with Sector Central Commander Mr Blessing Chitombo and discussed their relocation plans to the Central Darfur headquarters.
